Dancing Duck	Back Sack & Quack	4.2	A traditional mild recipe but full-bodied with bags of malty flavour. Black cherry, cola and toffee flavours with a caramel finish and berry aroma.	Cask	No	No

Nethergate	Melford Mild	3.7	Delightful, dark, easy-drinking mild with subtle hints of fruit and a bitter finish.	Cask	No	No
Papworth	Mild Thing	3.5	Traditional conker-coloured mild with light roasted malt flavours.	Cask	Yes	No
